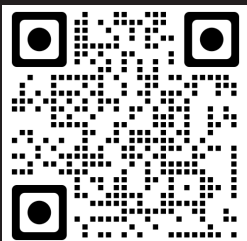

What is Deckhand?

Deckhand is an electronic logbook that empowers fishermen to collect data to streamline and inform their fishing business.

Who can use Deckhand?

Deckhand is for any commercial fishermen. NMFS reporting tools for trawlers and longliners are approved on a trial basis by NMFS in the Alaska Region. With provided NMFS authorization, vessels fishing with Deckhand can replace their paper logbook for federal reporting requirements. Deckhand is also available for use amongst trollers for a science-based and association backed reporting project. How do I get Deckhand?

Do I have to keep filling out NMFS paper logs during the project?

Short answer, no. With Deckhand, once your vessel has received authorization from NMFS (provided by Deckhand), you are no longer required to fill out paper logs so long as you have printing capabilities on board. Federal regulations currently require paper copies of your logs. Deckhand will print easy-to-read reports for both regulators and your own business records.

Will I always have to print?

The Deckhand team is working on fully electronic submission to NMFS by the end of 2024. Currently, federal regulations require hard copies: <https://www.ecfr.gov/current/title-50/chapter-VI/part-679>.
