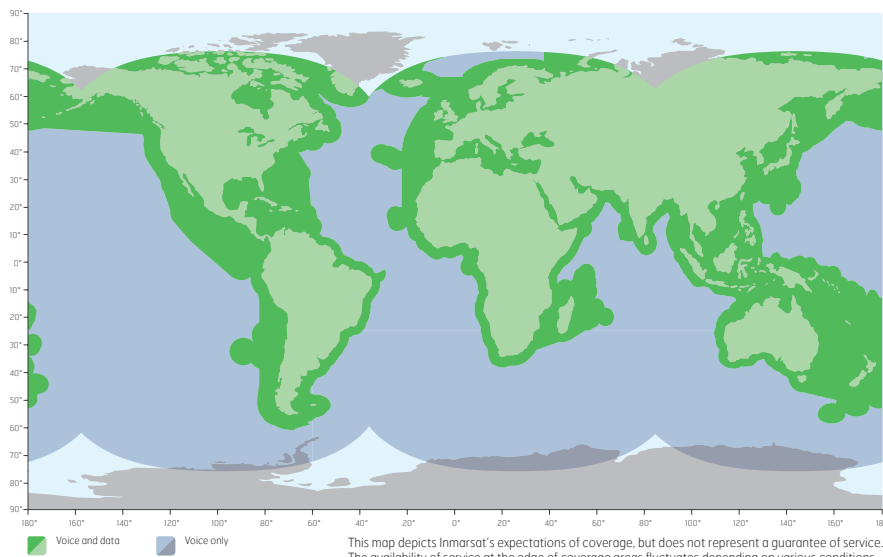


Fleet One can be quickly and easily installed and set up on your boat. Terminals operate globally and standardised user interfaces are used by all manufacturers.
